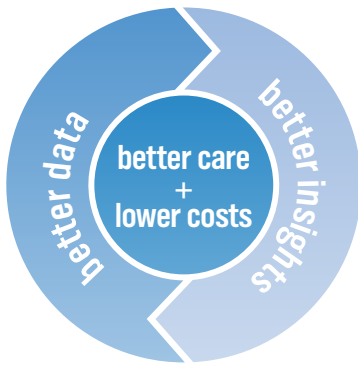

Specialty plans added must be fully insured and meet the following minimum participation of eligible medical employees: 50% each for dental and vision; 15% each for accident, critical illness and hospital indemnity; standard minimum participation applies to life and disability. Savings for life coverage applies when the total life schedule is insured with at least an equivalent volume of \$25,000 per covered employee and must include optional life when offered by employer. This program does not apply to embedded vision. Savings do not apply to balanced funding. Savings do not apply to National Account clients.
